Multi – Family Buildings: (Low Income and Non Low Income)

Up to 50 % of installed cost applicable to customers who install one or more of the above measures recommended during the site visit.

High Efficiency Heating System & Water Heating Rebate Programs

Through these programs, we want to increase customer awareness and promote the installation of high efficiency natural gas heating systems and high efficiency water heating equipment. This is good news for you and the environment.

To participate, simply download a rebate form at www.gasnetworks.com or obtain a rebate application from your energy auditor or call the number below. The rebate guidelines are as follows:
