Call 811 Before You Dig!

State laws require anyone who digs to notify utility companies at least **3 business days** (72 hours) before starting, for good reason. Digging can be dangerous and costly without knowing where underground facilities are located.

Dig Safe System, Inc. is a communication network, assisting excavators, contractors and property owners in complying with state law by notifying the appropriate utilities before digging. Dig Safe®, a free service, notifies member companies of proposed excavation projects. In turn, these member utilities respond to the work area and identify the location of underground facilities. Callers are given a permit number as confirmation.

Dig Safe does not, however, mark out customer owned natural gas lines, typically found after the natural gas meter. Under the law, customers are required to mark the location of any privately owned natural gas lines buried on their property prior to any excavation. Always insist that your contractor use hand tools when digging around natural gas lines.

Find licensed and qualified contractors capable of performing gas line locating services, repairs and leak surveys in your local phone book or by searching for underground locating services on the internet.



Digging is dangerous and costly if you don't know where underground facilities are buried. Utility accidents are harmful to life, property and the environment. They also disrupt vital utility services and cause work delays, expensive repairs, liability for damages and civil penalties.
